

Cyclo-Vets Board Meeting Jan. 7, 2002

Present: Adrienne Brian, Don Peters, Rich Cassens, Gordy Shields, Scott Mansberger

Treasurer's report (Scott): The treasury has \$9487.19, with some new members' checks possibly still outstanding. \$15,000 will be owed to Castelli when new clothing is delivered later this month. \$750 in sponsorship funds is expected from Diversified Legal Services. The Greg Laney fund will make a loan of \$2859.10 toward the cost of uniforms. The remaining funds will have to be obtained from an underwriter.

Web site (Don): The cost for conversion of the web site was \$50. Maintenance costs \$25/month. As of 1/1/2002 \$150 is owed for work on the web site. About 73 hours were needed to complete conversion of the web site, far more than originally estimated. While the Board was sympathetic to the idea of paying for the unanticipated extra work required, there was overriding concern about the pending expense for new uniforms.

Don noted that meeting at Doyle Park costs \$12 each time and suggested the Board meet at his home. The next Board meeting was set for Feb. 11 at 6:30.

Omnium update: Ralph Elliot will present a proposal for promoting the race. Increasing entry fees was discussed briefly.

A new issue of the MasterLink will come out at the end of January.
