

## **Cyclo-Vets Board Meeting Feb. 11, 2002**

**Present:** Adrienne Brian, Don Peters, Rich Cassens, Gordy Shields, Scott Mansberger, Gary deVoss, Chuck Gilbert, Kevin Gilbert

**Treasurer's report** (Scott): The balance in the treasury is 1421.09. The loan to the club for uniforms has been repaid. Insurance has been paid. A check is still expected from Phil Coats for advertising.

**Secretary's report** (Adrienne): The minutes from 1/7/02 were amended to reflect the status of Diversified Legal Services as an advertiser, not a sponsor as indicated in the minutes (see 1/7/02 Treasurer's report). The amended minutes were accepted.

**Membership report** (Rich): The club has 91 members. Problems were reported in sending out paper and email versions of the MasterLink due to illegible addresses (snail, email) on membership applications. Corrections when made should be passed on to Rich.

### **New Business**

**Race status report** (Gary): Sherri Newsome will assist with filing permits and will do registration. A race plan will be drawn up and distributed. A coordinator for the road race is still needed. Ralph Elliott will "organize physical arrangements" and will act a co-sponsor and promoter. Gary will serve as a liaison to Ralph. There was discussion of variations of the Great Western course for the road race, which would use Lyons Valley Rd. (ascent or descent) with a finish on Skyline Truck Trail.

**MasterLink** (Gordy): The MasterLink received a donation of \$100 from Don Peters.

**Web site** (Don): The web site has been updated with dates for the Omnium. Scott volunteered to do web site maintenance.

**Status re sponsorship/advertising** (Don) This is still an open committee chair. With no one assuming this responsibility there is some confusion concerning from whom checks are expected and the expected amounts. Kevin suggested that the club seek sponsorship for the race from one of the Indian casinos, either Sycuan or Barona.

**Training rides** (Don): Paul Gorman reports that there is very little participation in the E. county Saturday ride, raising the issue of whether the ride should be canceled. No decision was made. Don suggested that the club hold crit training sessions the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month. So far there has not been very much interest, but he will promote the idea on future rides. The participants could ride to the Huenekens crit course from Chili's.

**Miscellaneous:** Action on race points is still tabled. Don reported receiving many compliments on the new clothing. There was some discussion on which advertisers would continue their support, whether checks are still expected from Hi Tech Bikes, JW Flooring, and Phil Coats, and, if so, how much these checks should be for. Gordy noted that JW should be given a jersey. There was also discussion about having a club photo made for the advertisers.
